## The Value of Value Gear

s model builders we're always looking for ways to save time and achieve awesome results. Recently I was introduced to Value Gear (www.valuegeardetails.com) products by Bob Bethea. If you're not familiar with the company, they make resin stowage for armor vehicles, although that's not all they do.

Anybody who has ever built an armor kit knows that to make the model look realistic, it needs a lots of crew stuff hanging on it. As stowage is not usually provided with the kit, one has to spend time search through the parts box or pull out the A&B putty and start sculpting. Value Gear has a solution to this.

Value Gear produces stowage in four popular scales  $(1/16^{th}, 1/35^{th}, 1/48^{th})$  and  $1/72^{nd}$ . It uses fine quality resin with sharp details. You probably ask how much is this going to cost? Value Gear is just what the name implies: each set ranges from 12 to 16 bucks.

The set I recently used (D26) was designed specifically for the  $\underline{\text{DoM}}$ eLater (DML)  $1/35^{\text{th}}$  M26 Pershing kit, but it fits perfectly on the Tamiya kit also.




I used an airbrush to paint up most of the pieces after I had cleaned up the seams of which there were not many.



currently in use by the Ukrainian Army.



Kangaroo was a Canadian generic term for APC converted from a tank chassis. There were Stuart (M3/5), Priest (M7), and even Churchill Kangaroos! Most Kangaroos that saw actions were RAM (Canadian M3 Lee) based. Gecko Models now has a kit of it in 1/35<sup>th</sup>.

Sabre Model has a new JLTV out. Together with I♥Kit (Trumpeter) and RFM, there are now three different tooled 1/35<sup>th</sup> JLTV kits in the market!
